The New York City Human Resources Administration offers this Settlement Agreement ("Agreement") under its expedited enforcement procedures in order to settle its investigation of Clients subject to the following terms and conditions:

HRA hereby certifies that Clients have paid \$12,000.00 (the "Payment") to HRA as restitution, which HRA accepts as payment in full for its claims of overpayment of Medicaid ("MA")/Family Health Plus ("FHP") benefits previously received. The making of the Payment is not to be construed as an admission of wrongdoing on the part of Clients. In consideration for the Payment, HRA hereby releases Clients from all claims and causes of action, and further agrees that it will take no action and make no referrals to any third parties or governmental agencies against Clients or their family members for any allegations or claims arising from MA/FHP applications received from Clients, statements made by Clients or MA/FHP benefits paid to or on behalf of Clients or their family members on or prior to the date of this Agreement. The within certification only pertains to MA/FHP benefits received and has no bearing on any other type of assistance to which HRA retains its full right of recovery, if any.
